Nominations <u>must</u> include one letter of recommendation from a financial institution frequented by the nominee and one letter of nomination from a person(s) familiar with the nominee's professionalism and community involvement.

Nominations should include photographs or videos of the nominee's business and family.

From the nominations, five honorees will be selected. Each honoree and guest will receive an all-expense-paid trip to Chicago to attend the DTN/*The Progressive Farmer* 2018 Ag Summit. Honorees will be introduced there and will be featured in the *The Progressive Farmer magazine*.
